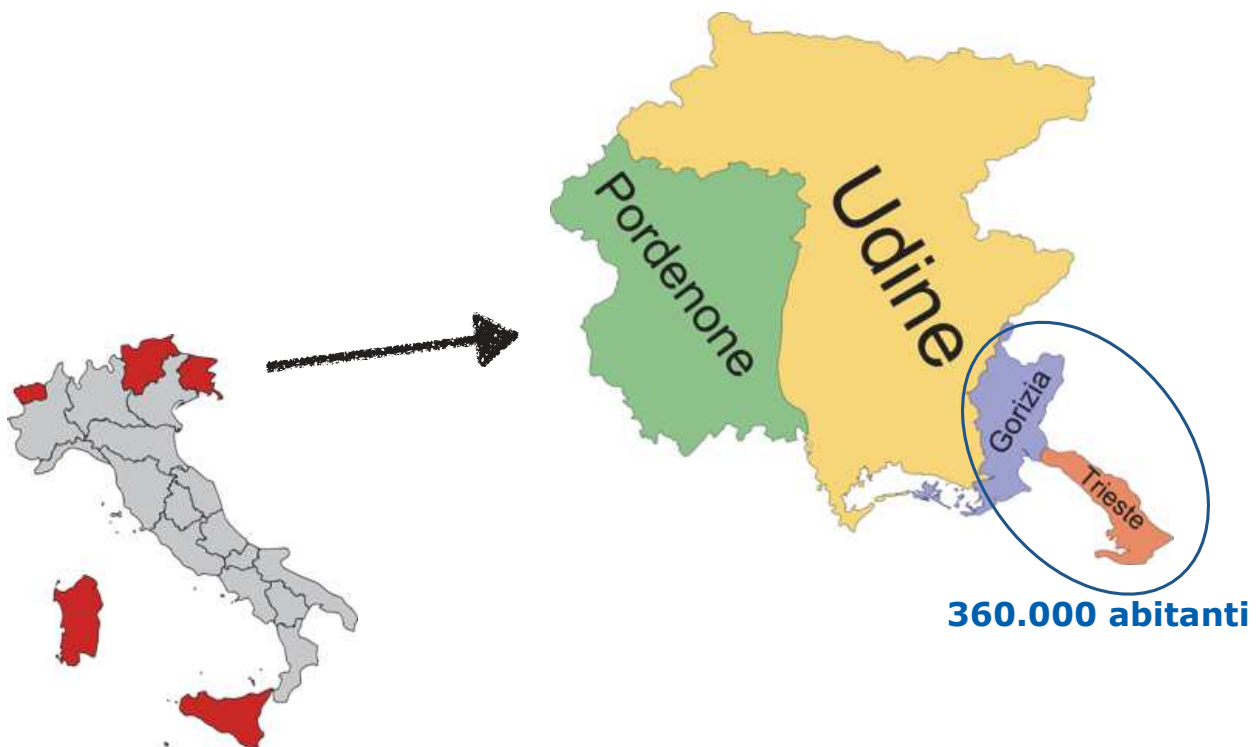
Open door and No restraint system



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Psychiatric Emergency Unit Features (1)

In the general hospital

6 beds

Open door

No restraint

Friendly habitat

No seclusion room

No video surveillance



Psychiatric Emergency Unit Features (2)

Bridge between hospital and community

Open to families, friends and user's social network

Attention to the user's needs, with the user

Strong work with families and friends

Flexibility and personalized crisis management

Negotiation as equals and alternative's offer

Personalized side by side assistance

User's Rights also during compulsory treatment

Compulsory treatment and rights

The person can:

- ✓ **Communicate to everybody outside the service**
- ✓ **Receive visits from families and friends**
- ✓ **Go out of the service with mental health operators for activities**
